Objectives

- Explore areas of unmet needs in head and neck cancer

- Develop HNCIG-specific translational research protocols as a stand alone, and to support clinical trials and data collection studies
- Review protocols submitted for consideration of HNCIG endorsement and provide recommendation(s) to the HNCIG Board prior to ratification
- Work closely with the Clinical Research Scientific Committee to develop joint studies and to mutually support their respective trials
- Work with Guidelines & Protocols Committee to produce guidelines to harmonise translational research methodology

Criteria for membership

- A member of one of the Member Groups of the HNCIG
- Endorsed by a member of the HNCIG Board (where applicant is not a Board member)
- Work in any specialty area involving head and neck cancers and/or related diseases
- Experience in developing research protocols preferable but not mandatory
